

Quick facts

- Cimicifuga prefers partial to full shade but dislikes dry shade. Avoid planting it under mature trees where it competes for moisture.
- Cimicifuga species are generally insect-free, which is why one of its common names is “bugbane”



Upon Arrival

- Open all boxes and bags immediately upon receipt
- Let the bare roots thaw out slowly
- Check the condition of the roots in the boxes
- If you notice any damage, please contact your sales rep within 7 days



Pot size

- Recommended pot size: Ø 17-19 cm; 1 bare root per pot



Planting

- Best time for planting is early spring.
- Check the bare roots before planting and discard any soft bare root
- Best temperature to start cultivation: 35-55°F / 2-12 °C
- Use well-drained, medium-moist soil
- Firm the soil around the roots to prevent air pockets
- Cimicifuga has to be planted with the eyes just below soil level
- Moderate temperatures are best; high heat can slow growth and scorch the foliage



Watering

- After first time watering, wait until the plants emerge before watering again
- Overwatering, or allowing the soil to get soggy, can cause root rot
- Regular watering is essential to maintain soil moisture



Ongoing care

- Cimicifuga is a low-maintenance plant once established
- Start fertilizing after the root system has developed well
- Apply a balanced, slow-release fertilizer in spring



Prevention and protection

- Cimicifuga can be susceptible to leaf spot and other fungal diseases, especially if the soil remains too wet. To prevent these issues, ensure well-drained soil and avoid overwatering
