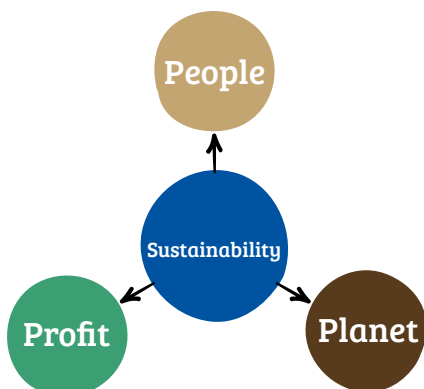

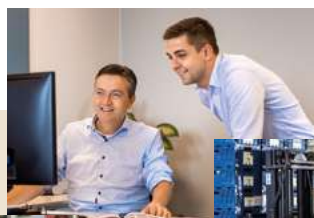
Pot tags

Upon Arrival

- Open all boxes and bags immediately upon receipt
- Let the roots/shrubs thaw out slowly
- Check de condition of the roots/shrubs in the boxes
- If you notice any damage, please contact your sales rep within 7 days
- Items that cannot tolerate storage should be planted immediately (check the planting table for priority planting on page 18)



Planting

- Do not plant roots that are still frozen
- Handle the roots with great care to avoid breaking of buds
- Check rhizomes before planting and discard any soft rhizomes
- Don't let roots dry out during potting
- How to plant the roots/shrubs: the plant table will provide guidance



Soil

- It is necessary to use a well-drained potting soil
- Firm the soil around the roots: prevent air pockets



Watering

- After first time watering wait till the plants emerge before watering again
- During growth, water as needed
- Overwatering, or allowing the soil to get soggy, can cause root rot
- Use your grower skills to closely monitor the growing



Greenhouse conditions

- Best temperature to start cultivation: the plant table will provide guidance



Claims

- We guarantee that all plants are true to name and of good quality when shipped. 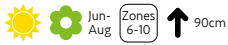

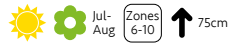

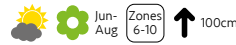
Acanthus (Bear's Breeches) **'mollis'**

- Spikes of showy mauve bracts revealing white flowers
- Semi-evergreen foliage

- Very decorative purple flowers with prickly purple foliage
- Decorative all the way until fall



Acanthus (Bear's Breeches) **'White Water' mollis**

- Gorgeous variegated foliage

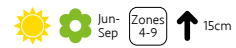

- Early spring flowering perennial
- *Iris germanica* is known as bearded Iris, flowers come in all colours
- German Iris plants prefer a full sun location but will bloom in light shade as well
- Too much shade and overcrowding are the most common reasons when Irises won't bloom



Upon Arrival

- Open all boxes and bags immediately upon receipt
- Let the rhizomes thaw out slowly
- Check the condition of the roots in the boxes
- If you notice any damage, please contact your sales rep within 7 days



Planting

- Best time for planting is early spring and fall
- Check rhizomes before planting and discard any soft rhizomes
- Best temperature to start cultivation: 35-55F / 2-12C°
- Plant rhizomes in a well-draining soil
- Top of the rhizome has to be visible after planting
- Irises should be fertilized in early spring about 6 to 8 weeks before bloom, and again after the blooms are gone



Watering

- First light watering after the plant has just sprouted
- During growth, water as needed (the soil should not be too dry or too wet)
- Overwatering, or allowing the soil to get soggy, can cause root rot



Ongoing care

- Use your grower skills to closely monitor the growing
- Bearded Iris (*Iris germanica*) is relatively carefree
- Remove the flower stalk after the last flower fades to stimulate plant growth



Prevention and protection

- Iris diseases can be caused by fungi, bacteria or viruses
- The fungi causing rhizome rots are generally found in the soil
- Rust is a wet weather, fungal disease
- Remove and dispose of all leaf debris at the end of the year

- Shrubs in containers need fertilizing from spring until late summer
- Removing spent flowers encourages further flowers, but is not essential and often not practical on large shrubs



Pruning

- Pruning can keep shrubs healthy, productive and attractive, as well as keep these compact.
- Don't get worried about pruning; Shoots that are growing in unwanted directions can also be pruned out



Prevention and protection

- Shrubs are usually very robust garden plants and if grown in conditions that suit their needs, they should be relatively trouble-free
- Positioning the shrub too deep in the soil can lead to stem rotting and shrub failure
- Poorly drained or waterlogged soil could kill your shrubs
- Remove and dispose of all leaf debris at the end of the year

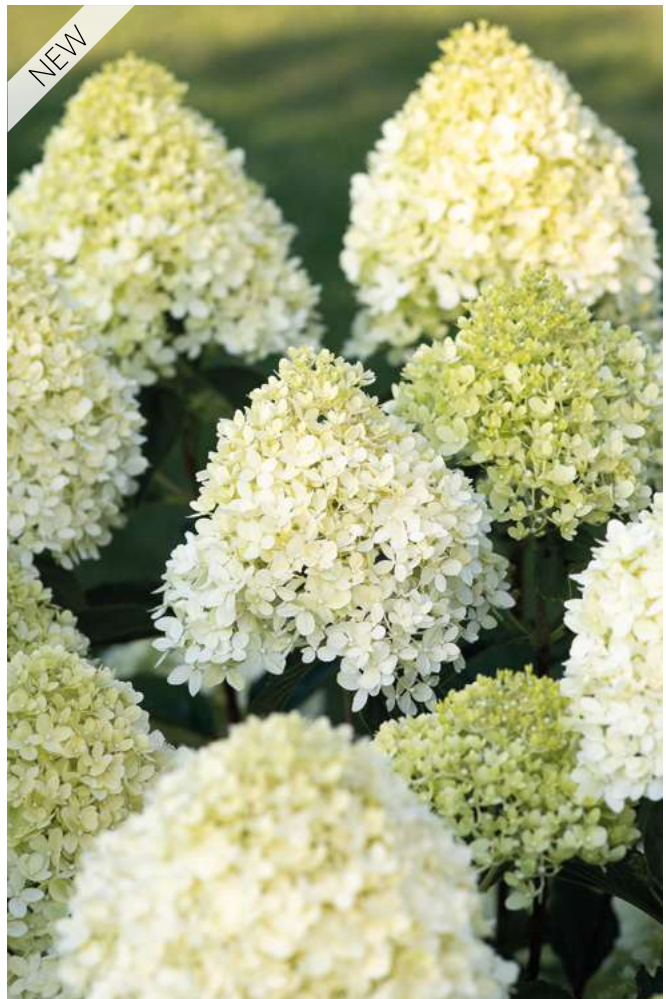

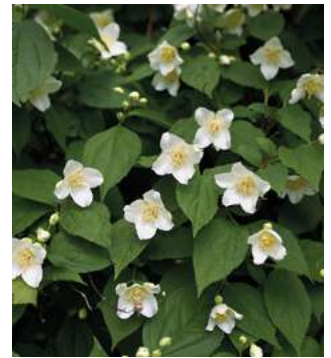

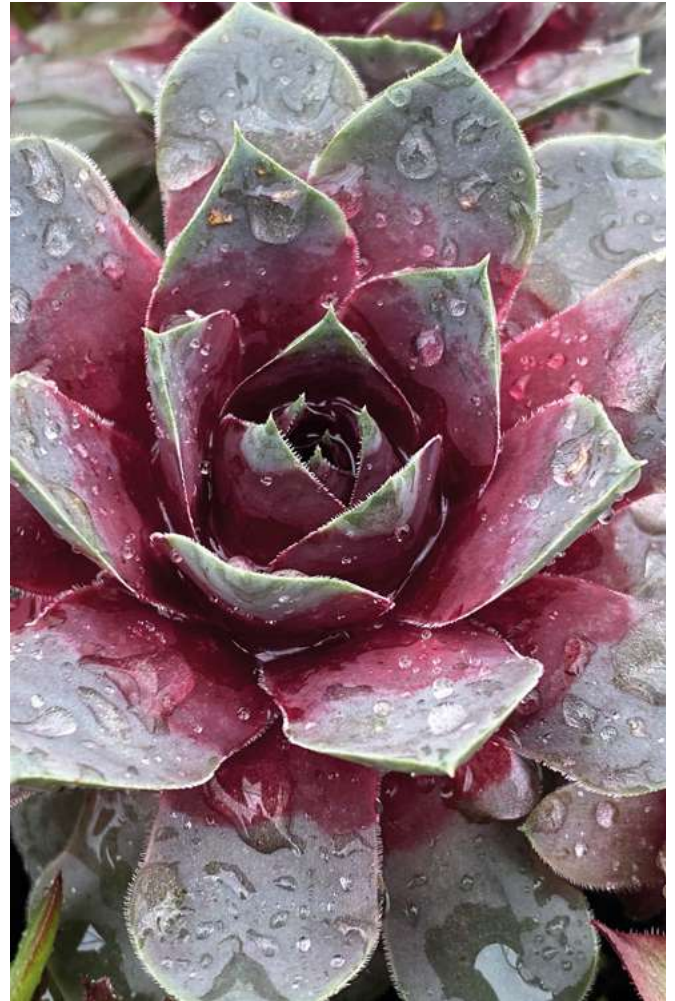
